Extended sociological study Jews of post-Soviet Euro-Asia

Notwithstanding the constantly changing circumstances facing the world in the short-term, EAJC leaders have been fully engaged in strategic decision-making for the long-term. The enlightening data obtained from the new extended study "Jews of post-Soviet Euro-Asia" initiated by the EAJC, plays a major role in the decision-making process.

The study offers indicative data regarding the status of Jewish life in the Euro-Asian countries as well as the prospects for its continued development.

Institute for Euro-Asian Jewish Studies





In the course of the large-scale survey of the Jewish population conducted by the Institute for Euro-Asian Jewish Studies (IEAEI) with the support of the Euro-Asian Jewish Congress, more than

2,000 respondents who met the criteria of the Israeli Law of Return, were interviewed, including more than 900 in Russia, 890 in Ukraine, 250 in Belarus, 350 in Moldova and 250 in Kazakhstan.



Establishment of a monument "Memorial Candle" in Jerusalem

January 23 – The city of Jerusalem hosted a special ceremony to inaugurate the Memorial Candle Monument, which is dedicated to the heroic defenders and fighters in Leningrad during World War II.

The ceremony was held under the sponsorship of Israeli President Reuven Rivlin and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu.

Also attending the ceremony were Russian President, Vladimir Putin; Mayor of Jerusalem, Moshe Leon; Governor of St. Petersburg, Aleksandr Beglov; President of the Euro-Asian Jewish Congress (EAJC) Dr. Michael Mirilashvili, chairperson of the board of trustees for Moscow's Jewish Museum and Tolerance Center, Viktor Vekselberg; President of the Russian Jewish Congress (RJC), Yuri Kanner; chairperson of the Jewish National Fund, Daniel Atar; mastermind behind the monument, Leonid Litinetsky; leaders of the World War II Veterans Society in Israel, Abraham Greenzide and Emilia Larina as well as foreign ambassadors and other distinguished guests.

The project was funded by the Euro-Asian Jewish Congress (EAJC), the Russian Jewish Congress (RJC), Viktor Vekselberg, the Jewish National Fund – Keren Kayemet LeIsrael and the Israeli Keren Hayesod foundation. The installation of the monument was backed by the city governments of St. Petersburg and Jerusalem.

Publishing projects



The Blockade Memory Pages collection was published in Israel. It collected the memories of people whose childhood fell on the period of the Leningrad siege, as well as those who helped the city to resist the enemy with all their might. As part of a special program aimed at preserving

the historical memory of the Jewish people, the Euro-Asian Jewish Congress initiated the translation and publication of this unique collection in Hebrew. The book is to be distributed among Israel's major libraries, universities, and schools.



Velvl Chernin's From Crimean Notebooks collection of essays on the field studies of some sub-ethnic groups of the Jews of the Crimean Peninsula has been published with the support of the EAJC. The book is unique because it introduces into scientific circulation the information obtained during ethnographic surveys of the late 1970s – early 1980s, when carriers of the Crimean cultural tradition were still alive.

Therefore, this publication of ethnographic materials about the Krymchaks is especially valuable.



The Euro-Asian Jewish Congress Yearbook "Jews of Europe and Asia: State, Heritage, and Prospects" (Russian: "Евреи Европы и Азии: состояние, наследие и перспективы") for 5779 (2018-2019) was released by the Institute of Euro-Asian Jewish Studies founded by EAJC, in academic cooperation

with the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Releasing the Yearbook, the EAJC regularly provides a timely overview of Jewish life in the Euro-Asian region to the Jewish public, the scientific community and the leadership of the states relevant to the EAJC Jewish communities.

The documentary film
"The Markish's Case" is a unique

is about the life of David Markish,
a writer and public figure.

"Markish's case" is not just movie, it's the writer's lively speech about his life, the history of the Jewish Anti-Fascist Committee, about the "refusal" and about the arrival of David Markish and his family to Israel, their life here, about the people with whom he had a chance to communicate, and also about books. The film consists of six series.

David Markish's a writer, author of a dozen novels, a publicist, a public figure, the son of a poet and one of the leaders of the Jewish Anti-Fascist Committee Peretz Markish. He has been living in Israel since the early 1970s. Markish is the winner of Israeli and foreign literary awards, many of his books have been translated into Hebrew and European languages.

Soon with the support of EAJC a bookbiography of David Markish in Hebrew will also be puplished.
